County of Wayne } ss; Sarah Adams a resident in the
town of Acadia in the County of Wayne, aged sixty
five - years, of sound mind, being duly sworn
says, that at the time of the Massacre at Wyoming by
the Indians and Tories, during the Revolutionary
War, she lived at Wilkesbarre in the State of Penn-
sylvania, and was among the inhabitants that
fled from there. that she had four brothers in the Army
then in service at that place, named William Dunn,
Thomas Dunn, Samuel Dunn and Levi Dunn, who
were in the battle at the time of the Massacre, that
William and Levi were killed there. that she
saw Samuel in the service at that time, she well
recollects. she knows he was in service and saw
him several ^{times} before and after the Massacre, and
was with him while she ^{was fleeing from} ~~left~~ Wilkesbarre and
that Samuel now lives in the town of Acadia
County of Wayne and State of New York.
