Only payment mentioned: for ninety nine years from the date hereof a grain of Indian corn yearly to be paid at the Feast of St. Thomas

### Description

A parcel of land (number acres not stated), adjoining land of **Mr. Luke Billington** and **Mr. Baylies**

**George Howell** and **Gregory Buispoole**

### Date

22 March 1665 (1666)

### Power of Attorney

**Capt. David Mansell** appointed **Thomas Freshwater** his attorney to make over the land to **Peeter Elder**
