400 acres in the County of Prince George (now Dinwiddie) on both sides of the Reedy Branch of Butterwood Swamp; “beginning at **William Poythress’s** corner red oak thence West two degrees North two hundred and forty seven poles to a corner pine thence North eleven degrees West two hundred and forty five poles to a corner white oak thence East by South three hundred and seventy four poles to **Poythress’s** line thence along the same South twenty two degrees West one hundred and ninety one poles to the beginning.”
