Description

280 acres in the County of Prince George (now Dinwiddie) on the South side of Butterwood Swamp; “beginning on **Peter Wynne’s** old line where **Samuel Moore** adjoins the same near a branch thence along the said **Wynne’s** old line West forty five poles to his corner thence North eighty four poles along his line to **Robert Poythress’s** corner in the same thence West two hundred and fourteen poles to a corner Spanish oak thence South one hundred and twenty poles to a corner pine thence South East one hundred and fourteen poles to a corner shrub white oak thence East five degrees North one hundred and ninety nine poles to **Samuel Moore’s** line thence North one hundred and two poles to the beginning.”
