James Elder & Jesse Mason are bound firmly
bound unto Beverly Randolph Esq. Governor
or Chief Magistrate of the State of Virginia in
the full sum of fifty pounds current money
of Virginia to the which payment we do
truly to be made ^{to the said Governor or his Successors} we bind ourselves our heirs
jointly & severally jointly by these presents
sealed & dated this 12 day of September
1789.

The Condition of the above
obligation is such that whereas there is a
marriage shortly intended to be had & solemn-
ized between the above bound James Elder
& Pally Mason & therefore there be no
lawfull cause to obstruct the same then
this obligation to be void else to remain
in full force & virtue &
sealed & delivered in
