An inventory of the Estate of _____ **Mason**, dec'd returned to April term 1817 – One bed and furniture, 5 head of horses, 8 head of cattle, 28 head of hogs, 13 acres of corn, 1 chest, 1 table, 7 chairs, 3 wheels, 2 dishes, 6 plates, 3 basons, 1 pot and hooks, oven and hooks, 1 skillet, 1 gun, 1 set candle moles, 1 pair of sheep shears, 1 slate, 2 hoes, 1 grubbing hoe, 2 plows, 2 pr. drawing chains, 2 singletrees, and clevis, 1 frow, 2 iron wedges, 1 flat iron, 1 jointer, 1 saw and drawing knife, 1 card, 1 loom, 1 five gallon jug, 3 barrels, 1 barrel salt, 2 hogsheads, 3 axes, 1 \$6 note on **Jno. Hutton** – 1 for \$4.25 on **Obadiah Mason**, 1 do on **James Elder** for \$3.64, one do on **Benj'm Hancock** for \$16.12½, 1 do on **William Alford** for \$1.75, 1 do on **Wm. Nothery** \$4 – 1 man's saddle, 2 raw hides, 1 reel, 1 pair saddle bags, 3 bells, 1 sive, one account on **Obadiah Mason** for \$6.67 cts, one on **Coleman Mason** for \$1.87½ cts, parcel of flax, 1 coopers hammer, 1 pr compasses, 1 round shave, 1 chisel, 1 hatchet, 1 churn, 1 flat tub, butter pot, 1 woman's saddle, 1 pair nippers.
