WILL

PROBATED SEPT. 19, 1916.

- - Last Will and Testament of J.S.Logan. - -
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I, J. S. Logan, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills at any time heretofore made by me.

Item One: I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid out of any moneys on hand at my death, or out of the first moneys to come into the hands of my Executrix.

Item Two: Subject to the payment of my debts and funeral expenses I give and devise all my property, real and personal, to my Executrix hereinafter named, for the following uses and purposes, to-wit: As long as my wife lives I direct that my Executrix pay to her \$10.00 each month, and pay to my daughter, Malissa, \$5.00 each month, and in case of sickness of my wife or daughter, Malissa, to pay all doctors or Medical bills, and after the death of my wife all that remains of my estate shall be divided equally by my Executrix between my nine children.

Item Three: My Executrix is authorized and directed to sell my tract of land in Sixth, formerly Ninth, Civil District of Davidson County, Tennessee, opposite the place where I now live, and may sell on time, taking notes bearing interest. I suggest that the unimproved part be first sold but my Executrix may do as seems best to her.

Item Four: I appoint my daughter, Malissa Logan, Executrix of this will and direct that no bond be required of her.

Signed and published, this 2nd day of March 1914.
