A report of the commissioners appointed to  
lay off to the widow of Wiley Turbeville his widow's provision  
we the undersigned sheriffs of Marion County after being duly sworn have  
proceeded to set apart to the widow of Wiley Turbeville his so much of the proceeds  
as we found which not being as much as we deemed necessary for her and  
her families support the year but it being all besides what the law allowed  
her descent from her estate we found no provision and proceeded to value  
what other property we found belonging to the estate also notes and sold  
off the whole and amounting to within thirteen dollars and sixty cents of  
what we deemed necessary Given under our hands April 23. 1848
